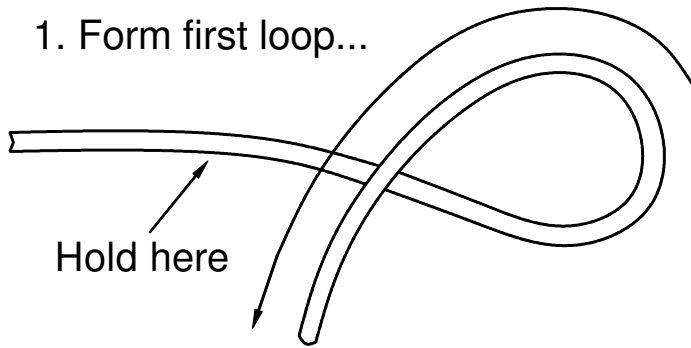


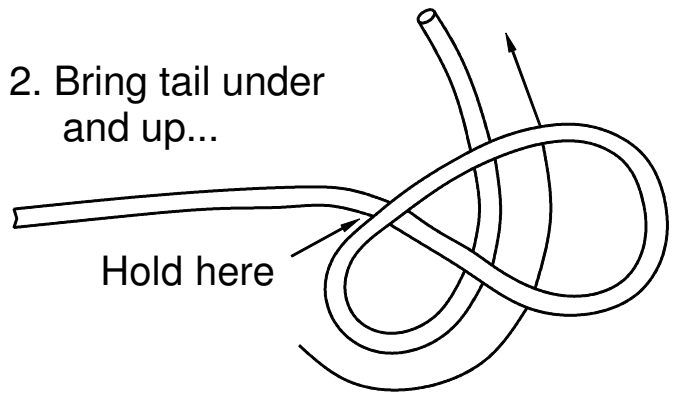
# Ashley's Stopper Knot

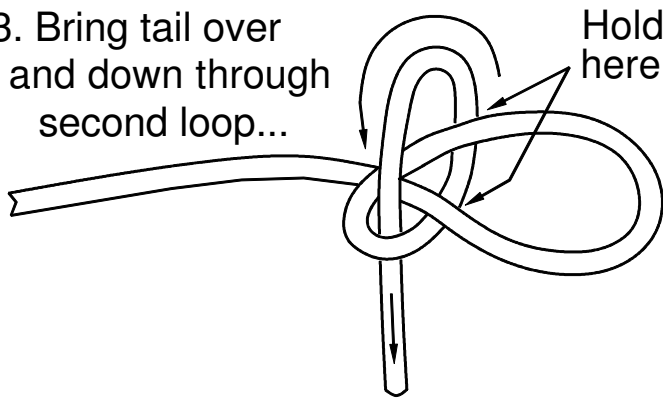
1. Form first loop...



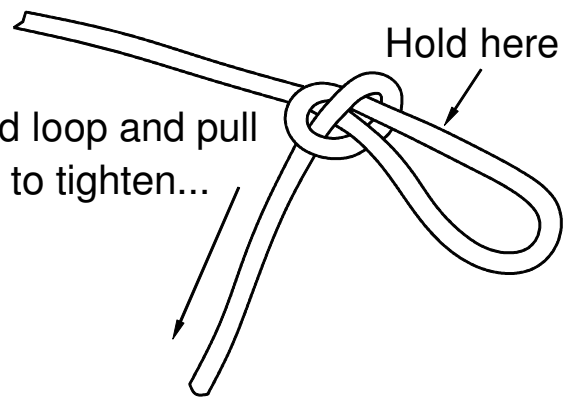
2. Bring tail under and up...



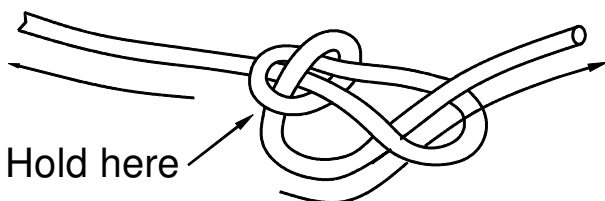
3. Bring tail over and down through second loop...



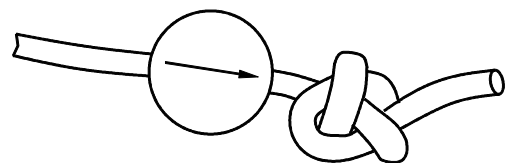
4. Hold loop and pull tail to tighten...



5. Feed tail through loop and pull both ends firmly to tighten knot.



6. Cut excess tail and add bead to string if desired.



Use this knot to secure ukulele string ends when instruments have bridges designed to have the strings secured under the bridge plate inside the ukulele body.
